About CASA

Children who have been abused and neglected by the very people who should love them and keep them safe are generally age 11 and under, too young to defend themselves. These victims need a champion, a voice, in order to survive and break free of their dire situation.



CASA provides a voice for abused and neglected children.

National CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocate) is a non-profit organization with over 900 chapters. CASA recruits and trains community volunteers who serve as advocates for abused and neglected children in court.

Colonial CASA, a member of National CASA, serves James City County, Williamsburg, Poquoson, and York County. We ensure that the abused and neglected children in our community do not get lost in the legal system. The CASA volunteer provides a voice for the victim in court and assists the judge in making a decision regarding a safe and permanent placement for the child.
